



Sanad Lebanon holds the “Second Educational Coordination Meeting” To support the public school

In coordination with the Ministry of Education and in the presence of the President of the educational district in Nabatiyeh Mr.Akram Abu Shakra represented by Mr.Mahmoud Makki, Sanad Lebanon held the second

educational coordination meeting at its center in the town of Haris, attended by the directors of public schools within the scope of the Union of Bint- Jbeil Municipalities, to discuss the educational matter, especially how to start the new school year, which is associated with a number of educational, economic, social and technical challenges.

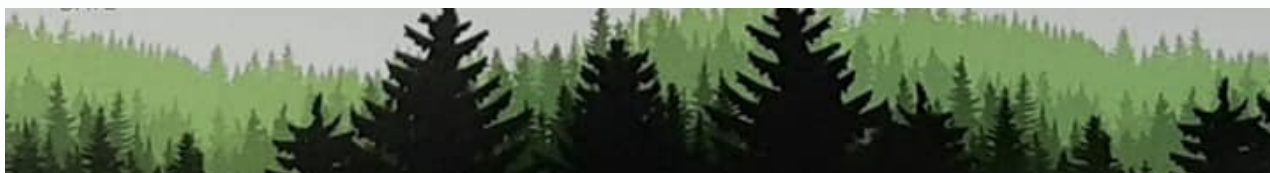


Sanad Lebanon Cultivates 100 cedar trees in Ehden Reserve

To complement the public school support program, Sanad Lebanon has prepared a study about “the reality of the public school” within the scope of the Union of Municipalities of Bint Jbeil and the Neighborhood, which includes 19 public secondary schools, middle schools, and primary schools, 5992 students and 614 Professors. The study explains the general problems of the new school year 2022-2021, and describe the reality of the technological and digital capabilities of teaching staff, the state of halls and the absorptive capacity of schools, the technological and digital equipment, and a detailed explanation of the requirements of the ideal classroom and technological laboratories. Then an explanation of the implementation mechanisms within a three-year plan that draws the line for the development of these schools with a scientific methodology that can be applied and implemented.
